Chase the Ace Contest Rules

2021

Lottery License

Tickets may only be sold within Saskatchewan

- Tickets sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.
- Ticket price is \$5.00. A maximum of 80,000 tickets may be sold, with a total prize value of \$200,000.
- Every Thursday evening between 5:30 and 8:00 pm we will sell tickets for the draw that week, at the Lumsden Hotel & Steak Pit. Tickets can be purchased up until 8:00 pm and the draw will take place immediately. Draws will commence on Feb 4, 2021 and finish on Dec 16, 2021.
- Tickets will be available from Lumsden & District Lions members during the week. Tickets may also be purchased by e-transfer at lumsdenlionscta@gmail.ca. Your ticket will be written out and an email or text will be sent to you confirming your purchase.
- Random ticket draw takes place at 8:00 pm – winner gets 20% of ticket sales from that week. One winning ticket will be drawn each Thursday evening.
- The winning ticket holder's name will be called out three times, to determine if they are present at the draw location.
- Holder of the winning ticket must be present to claim prize. If holder of the winning ticket is not present, a Charity Appointed Proxy will be used to complete the draw.
- Distribution of weekly ticket sales: 20% will be awarded to the winning ticket holder, 30% will be added to the growing Jackpot. 50% will go the Lumsden & District Lions Club.
- Draw winner (or proxy) gets chance to win the Jackpot by cutting the deck of cards.
- The designated Charity Appointed Proxies are Bob Hill and Raylene Pingert.
- If the Ace of Spades is chosen from the deck of cards, the winner gets the Jackpot, which includes the 30% of the week's ticket sales.
- If the Ace of Spades is not drawn, the selected card is removed and the 30% goes into the growing Jackpot.
- At the end of each week's "cut the deck" segment, the rest of the deck will be displayed, to show that the Ace of Spades is still in the deck.
- Contest continues with the same deck of cards until the Ace of Spades is drawn.

- Once the Ace of Spades is drawn whether it is week 1 or week 21, – a new contest begins. The Jackpot resets, and a new deck of cards will be used.
- Only tickets sold during the current week are eligible for that week's draw. All previous tickets sold will be removed from the draw drum at the conclusion of each weekly draw.
- The Lumsden & District Lions Club limits the number of tickets available for purchase to 1 book (25 tickets) per day.
- No refunds will be allowed for any ticket purchased.
- No receipts will be given for any ticket purchased.
- If the winning ticket has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to the first person's name on the Ticket. It is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to distribute their winnings.
- Lumsden & District Lions members and their family will be permitted to purchase tickets, but are not permitted to participate as the Ticket Draw Person in that week's draw. Volunteers who are assisting directly with the draw, including putting raffle ticket into the draw drum, that evening, are not permitted to purchase tickets for that draw.
- The raffle will continue for the duration of the SLGA license. The final draw will take place on December 16, 2021 at the Lumsden Hotel and Steak Pit (30 2nd Avenue, Lumsden, SK).
- Total ticket sales for the duration of the Lottery shall not exceed 80,000 in number. In the event that all 80,000 tickets are sold before December 16, 2021 the draw will take place the Thursday that the final ticket is sold, with the Winning Ticket Holder receiving \$20% of the weekly sales, and will be given a chance to cut the deck of cards for the Ace of Spades. IF the ticket holder does not cut the Ace of Spades, they will keep the 20% of the weekly ticket sales, with the remaining 30% to be added to the Jackpot, and another ticket will be drawn. Tickets will continue to be drawn, until a ticket holder cuts the Ace of Spades from the remaining deck of cards, who will then receive the Jackpot total that has accumulated to that time, bringing the Chase the Ace event to its conclusion.
- Depending of the value of the prize pot, the winner may be required to come to the Lumsden & District Lion Club with ID to claim winning in the form of a cheque.
- Winners of the weekly 20% will have a cheque processed within the next three business days.
- Winner of the 30% Jackpot will have a cheque processed within the next three business days.
