



## **Lumsden Lions Plant a Tree Program** **in conjunction with Lumsden High School Outdoor School Class**

From “Chase the Ace” fund raiser, Lumsden Residents and area have an opportunity to get a free tree to plant to beautify our community and help save our planet.

The trees are available on May 22<sup>nd</sup> on a first come first serve basis from 8 am to 12 pm, in front of Lumsden High School.

Because of COVID-19 restrictions vehicles are asked to line up North of the high school on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and merge on to Broad Street. As you drive through the LHS Parking lot, students will ask you which of the 5 tree choices you would like. **You are asked to remain in your vehicles as students load the tree.** You will continue South and exit the parking lot.

### **Because of COVID-19 restrictions note the following important information:**

- **You are asked to remain in your vehicle at all times and the students will load your tree.**
- We will allow vehicle traffic only (no walk ups allowed).
- Vehicles line up North of the high school on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and merge on to Broad Street – watch for signs.
- As you drive through the front LHS Parking lot, physically distanced students will ask you your choice of tree.
- **Exit:** continue South to exit the parking lot – watch for signs.

Other notable points:

1. Only one tree per vehicle
2. Your choice of trees while they last are:
  - a. 2 gallon Black Hills Spruce
  - b. 2 gallon Colorado Blue Spruce
  - c. 5 gallon Little Leaf Linden
  - d. 5 gallon Amur Maple
  - e. 5 gallon Maricana Ash

There are 240 trees available for pick up.

3. Each tree will have a handout describing your trees needs and planting instructions.
4. A yellow ribbon will be attached to each tree signifying that your tree is a “Lumsden Lions Project Tree”. Please leave the ribbon on the tree for a time, would be appreciated.
5. If you are not physically capable of planting your own tree, Students from LHS will plant your tree for you. Students will not be permitted to plant trees outside town limits due to safety concerns.
